



Internship Placement

During each academic year, the majority of programmes require that students successfully complete a 4-6 month internship period in a hospitality establishment approved by BHMS. Students undertaking an internship in Switzerland will be under contractual obligation with their employers, which will entitle them to receive a trainee's gross monthly salary of CHF2,359.
